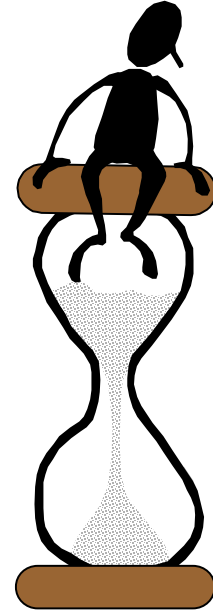


# JAKKALSE EN GEDULD GET OUT OF DODGE!



It is a pretty well known thing that we need patience, en klomp geduld when calling these critters. But we must also remember this tip..... I give many tips and advice on my site and this is one of them.

If I am hunting a place and I sit at one spot and call an hour, and even if I shoot something, and then my next 2 spots bring in nothing, no success, I then do not sit another 5 minutes in the same camp.

I pack up and drive and move out of that area totally, and get at least two kilometres away and call again, it is vital to get out of an area that is offering no responses.

Yesterday my partner was calling at a spot, he shot a jackal on one hour, then the next two was dead, he moved out of the area and within 20 minutes shot another with the dying jack rabbit sound and territorial barks, on two callers apart and this combo works very well as usual.

So, get out of areas that offer little response, seek fresh ground and work from that new spot onwards.....
